\$45.00 – Saturday Only

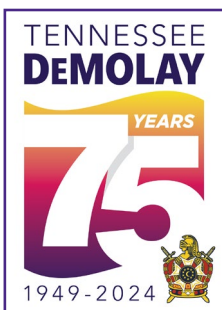
If you make a reservation you will be required to pay even if you do not attend.

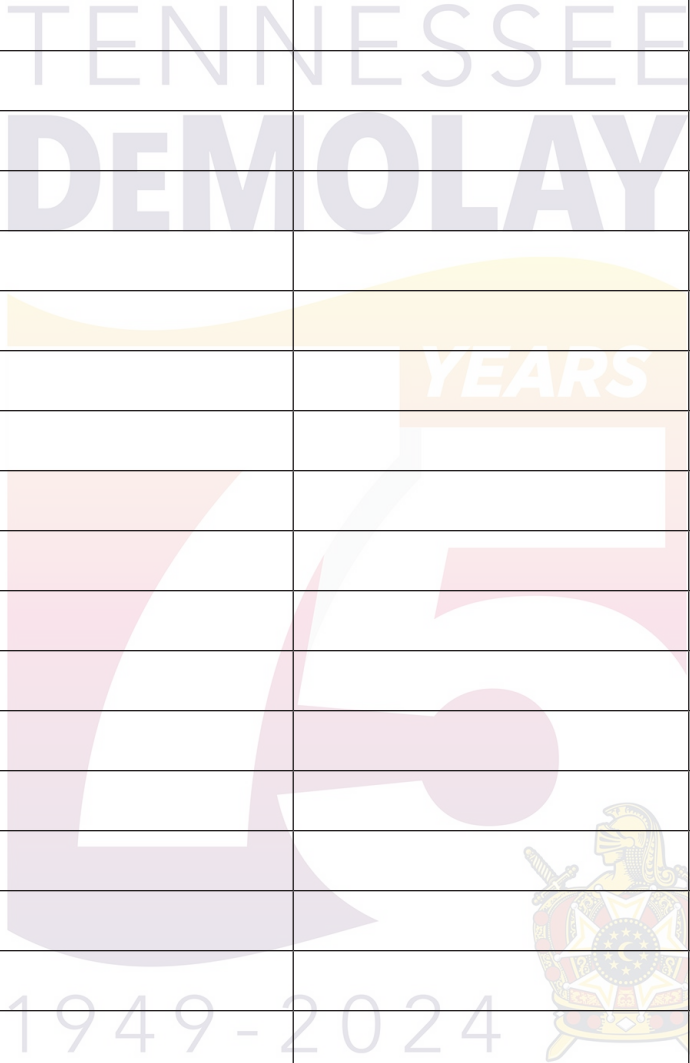

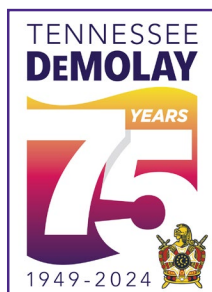

TDU RULES FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS – Please Read Carefully

- Advisors will be responsible for their Chapters conduct and for the enforcement of all TDU rules
- No DeMolay may attend TDU without an Advisor from his Chapter or an adult appointed to him.
- Attendance of DeMolays and Advisors is mandatory at all workshops and meetings. Individuals not in attendance will be subject to forfeiture of any and all camp privileges as well as fees paid. The Chapter Advisor will meet with the Director and the TDU staff to discuss the absence.
- Fishing or other lake activities may take place before breakfast or during designated free-time only.
- TDU is not intended for small children and due to insurance regulations, we ask that no children under 10 accompany adults to TDU unless absolutely necessary. If so, children must be supervised by an adult at all times and must be kept clear of meeting sites during scheduled workshops.
- Girls and sweethearts are not allowed to attend TDU unless specifically approved by the Knighthood Director in advance to assist in the kitchen or help with a workshop class.
- Dress code for all TDU functions is casual. However, any attire considered inappropriate or in bad taste by the discretion of the TDU staff and advisors will not be allowed.
- DeMolays are only allowed in buildings designated for TDU use and only during the designated time period.
- Discretion is to be used at all times within the dorm area. No camp property is to be damaged or removed. All facilities including restrooms, dorms, lobbies, meeting areas and grounds are to be kept clean and debris is to be placed in proper containers.
- There will be no changing of room or bunk assignments and participants are responsible for any damage occurring in or activities conducted in their assigned area. Participants are required to be in assigned quarters during lights out time. No exceptions.
- DeMolays will conduct themselves as gentlemen at all times: TDU participants will show respect at all times to Advisors, Staff Members, Moms, and each other through their speech, attitudes and actions.
- Alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, fireworks, incense, profane language or shaving cream (other than for the purpose of shaving) are strictly prohibited. Prescription Drugs are allowed but must be indicated on the Parental Consent Form.
- Tobacco products of any kind may only be used outdoors in designated areas and only by persons who are of legal age to do so.
- No stereo systems, televisions or amplified musical instruments are allowed on grounds. Personal music players are allowed in the dorm but should not be heard outside.
- Participants must remain on camp grounds during TDU unless given permission by their Chapter Advisor and only if accompanied by an advisor or staff member.
- Failure to comply with these rules will result in immediate dismissal from TDU. Fees are not subject to refund.
